




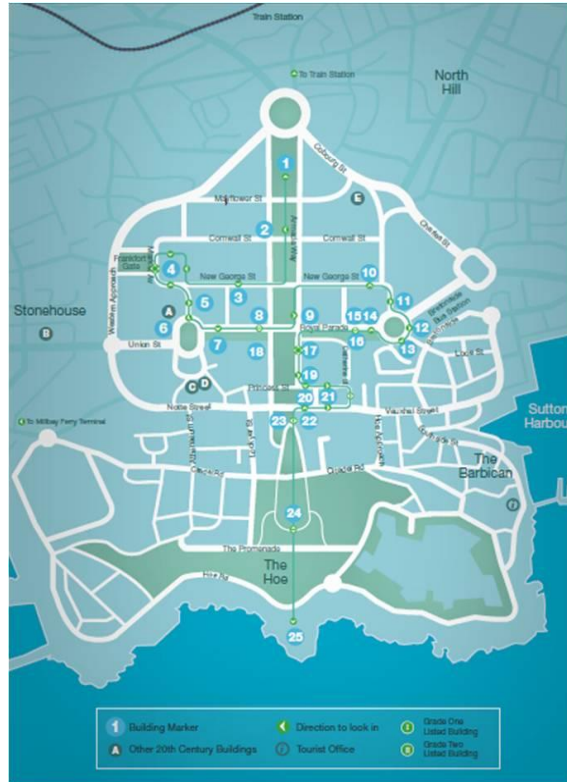


- A.**  **Braille Garden (c.1958)** Where in Plymouth city centre is the Braille Garden?
